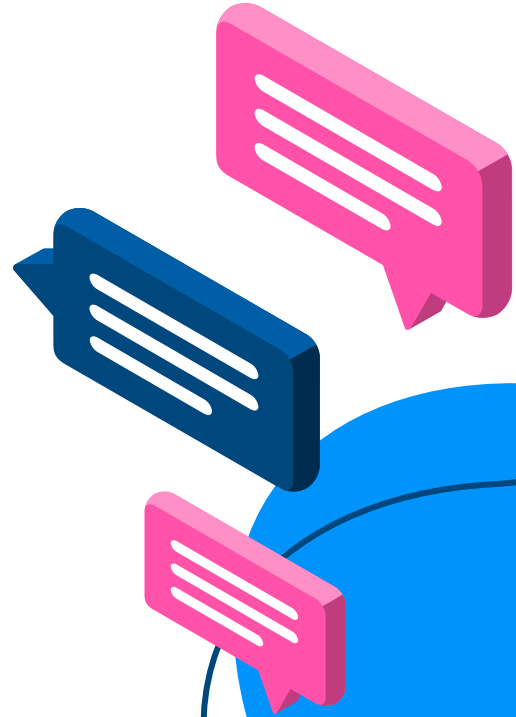


# Interaction

Frayer Model





NOTE:

Students should understand the concepts “**relationship**,” “**cause and effect**,” and “**impact**” *before* proceeding with this activity.

This activity ends with students completing a **Fray Model**.

Interaction is when an **action** by something (living or nonliving) has an **effect** on something else (living or nonliving).



The picture is an example of an **interaction**.

The owner's **action** (petting the dog) probably has the **effect** of making the dog feel loved.

Some **actions** that may have an **effect** on others might be

- Smiling at someone walking by.
- Asking for for directions.
- Saying “Hi.”

These actions could begin an **interaction**.

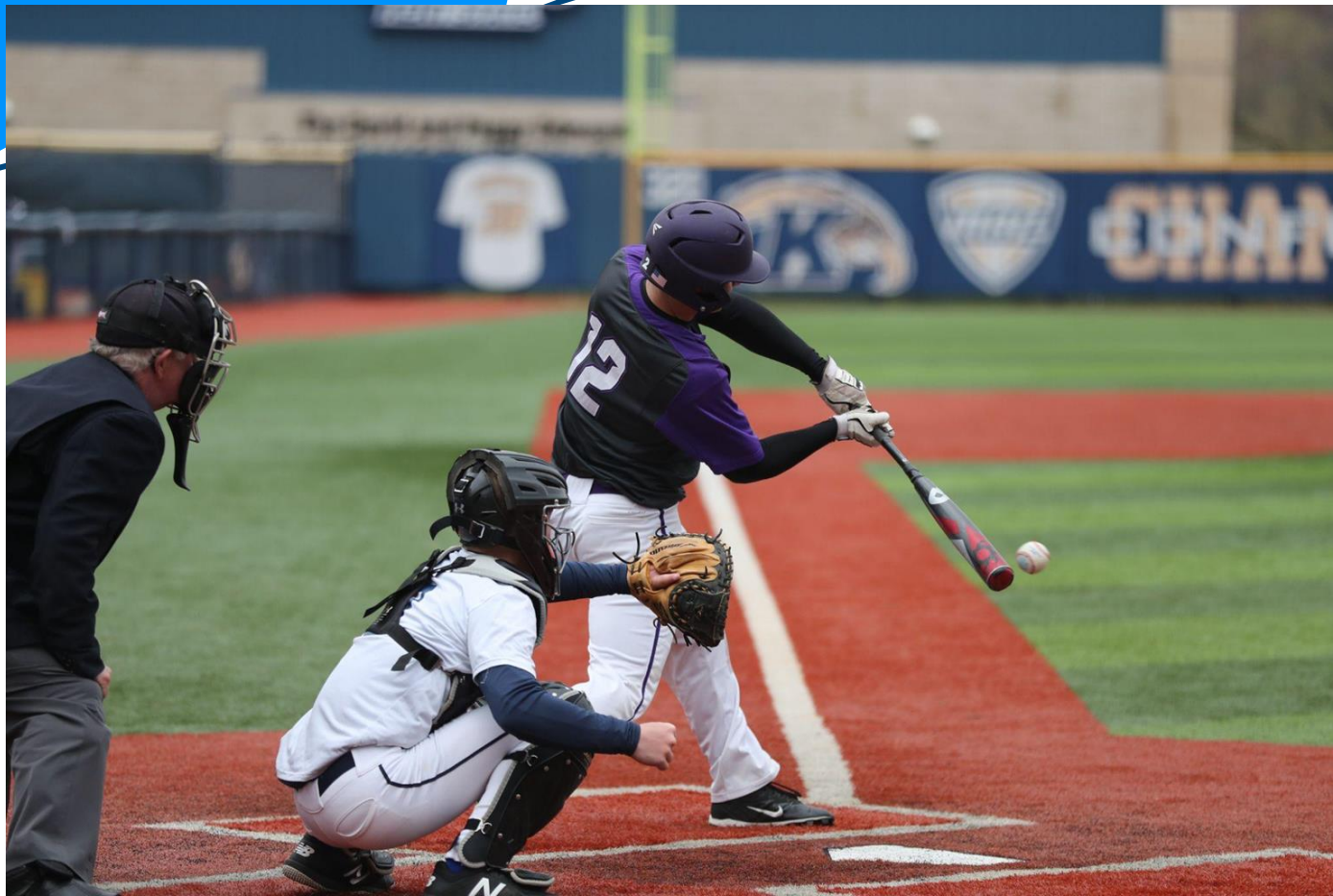
