

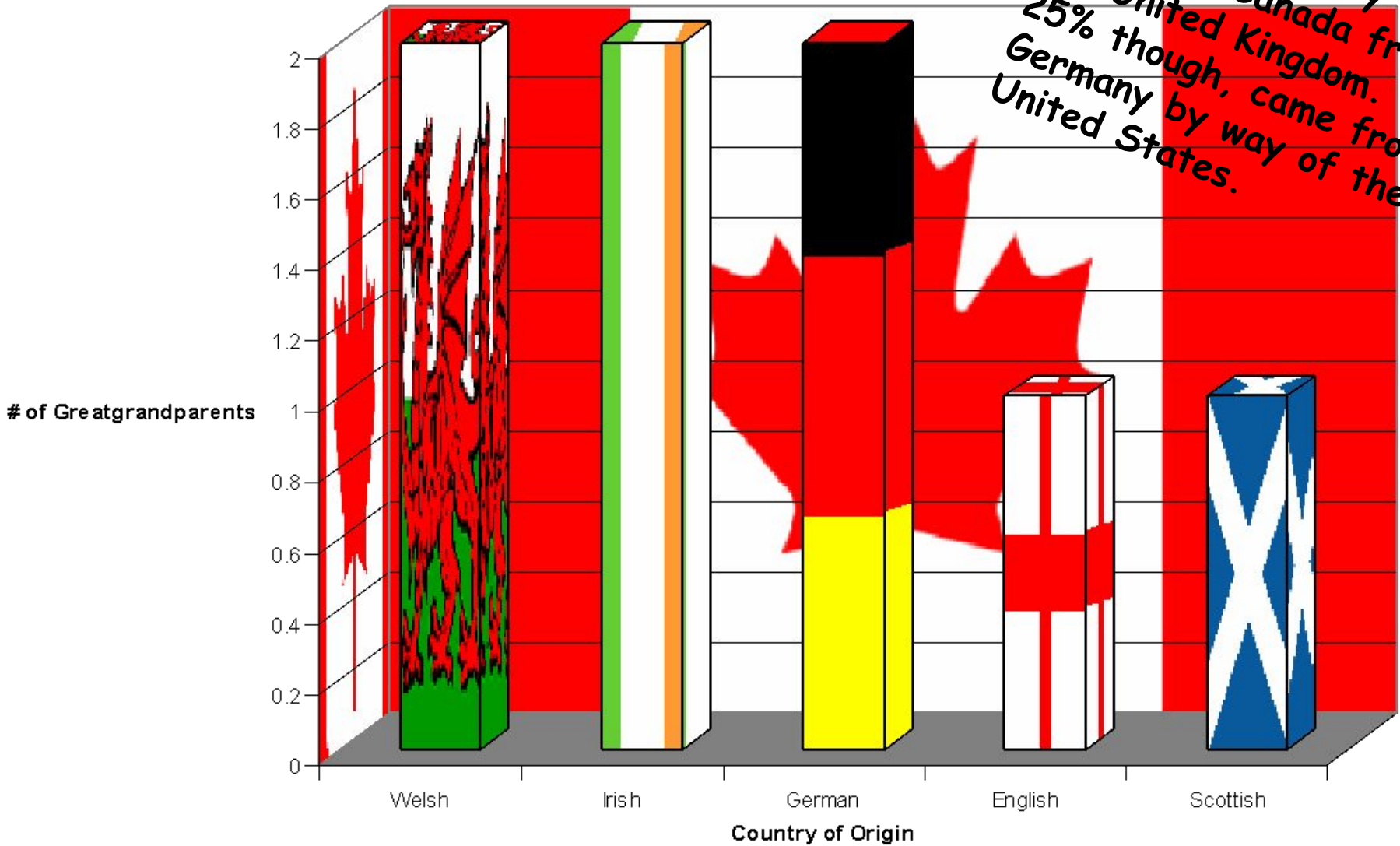

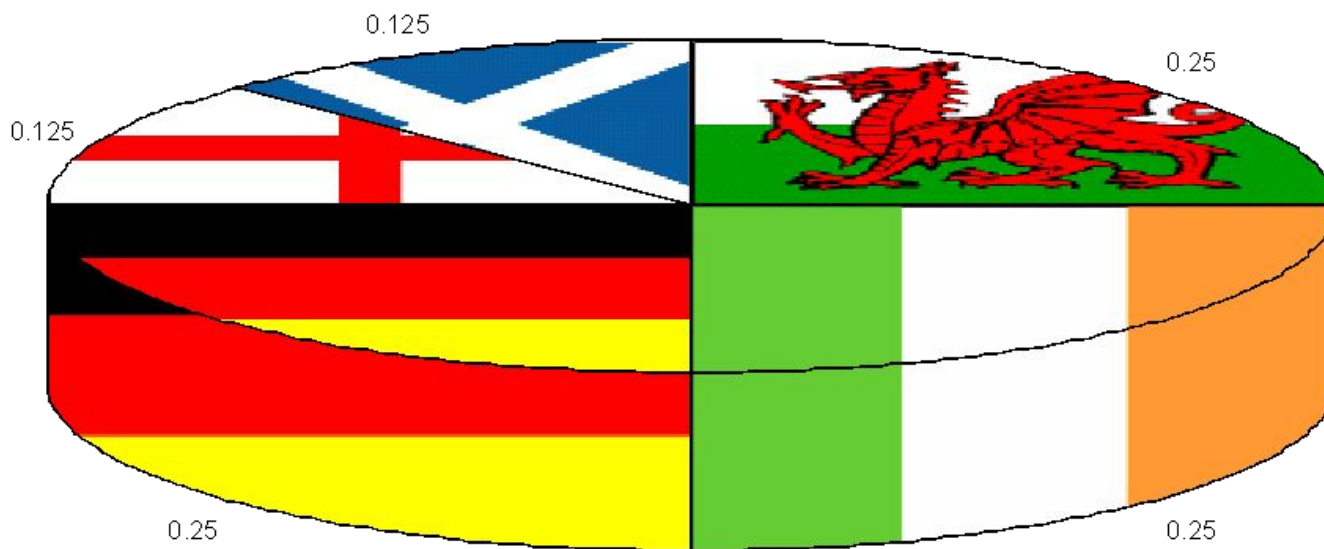
# Ethnic Origins in My Family

*Percentages expressed in decimal format.*



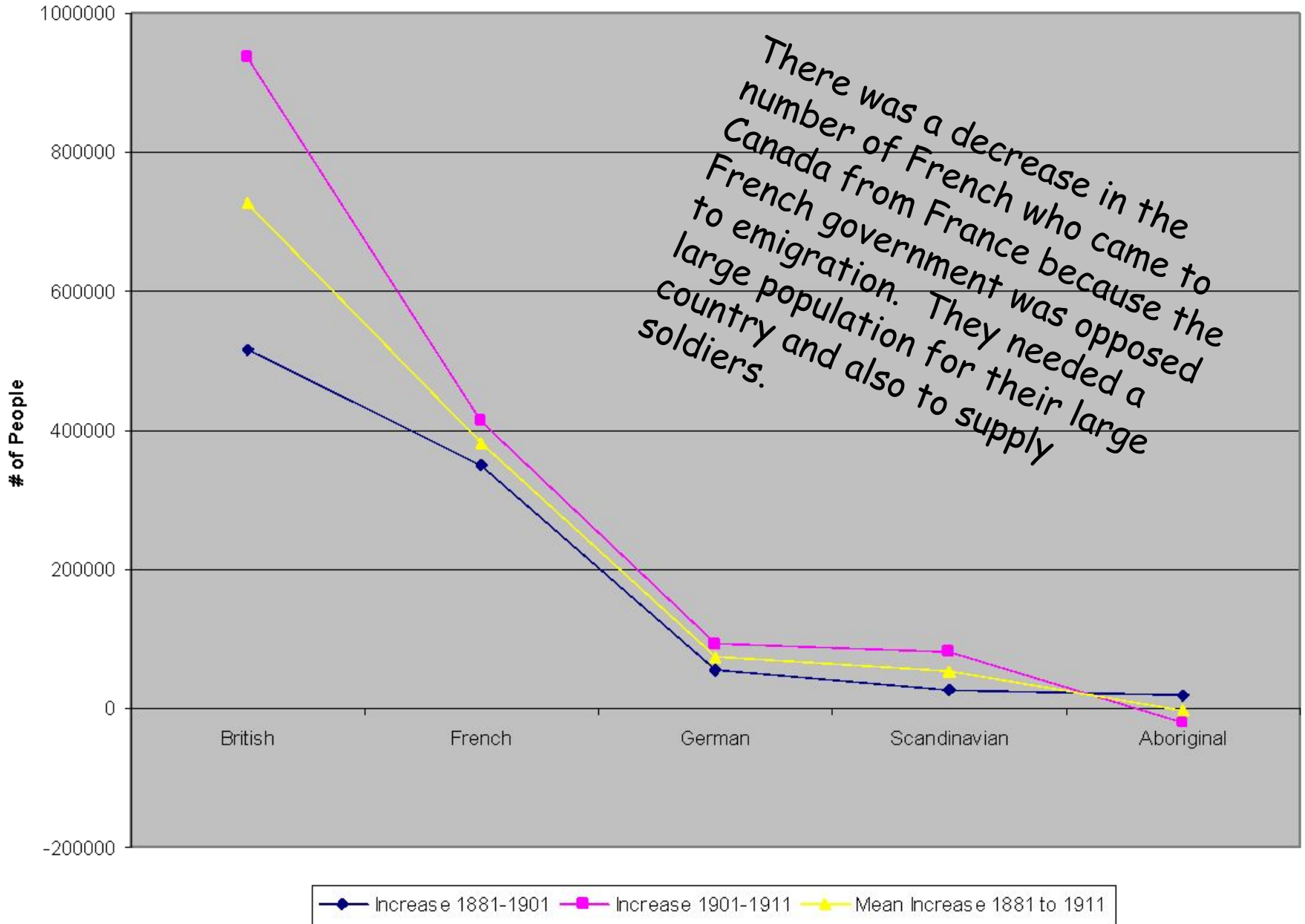

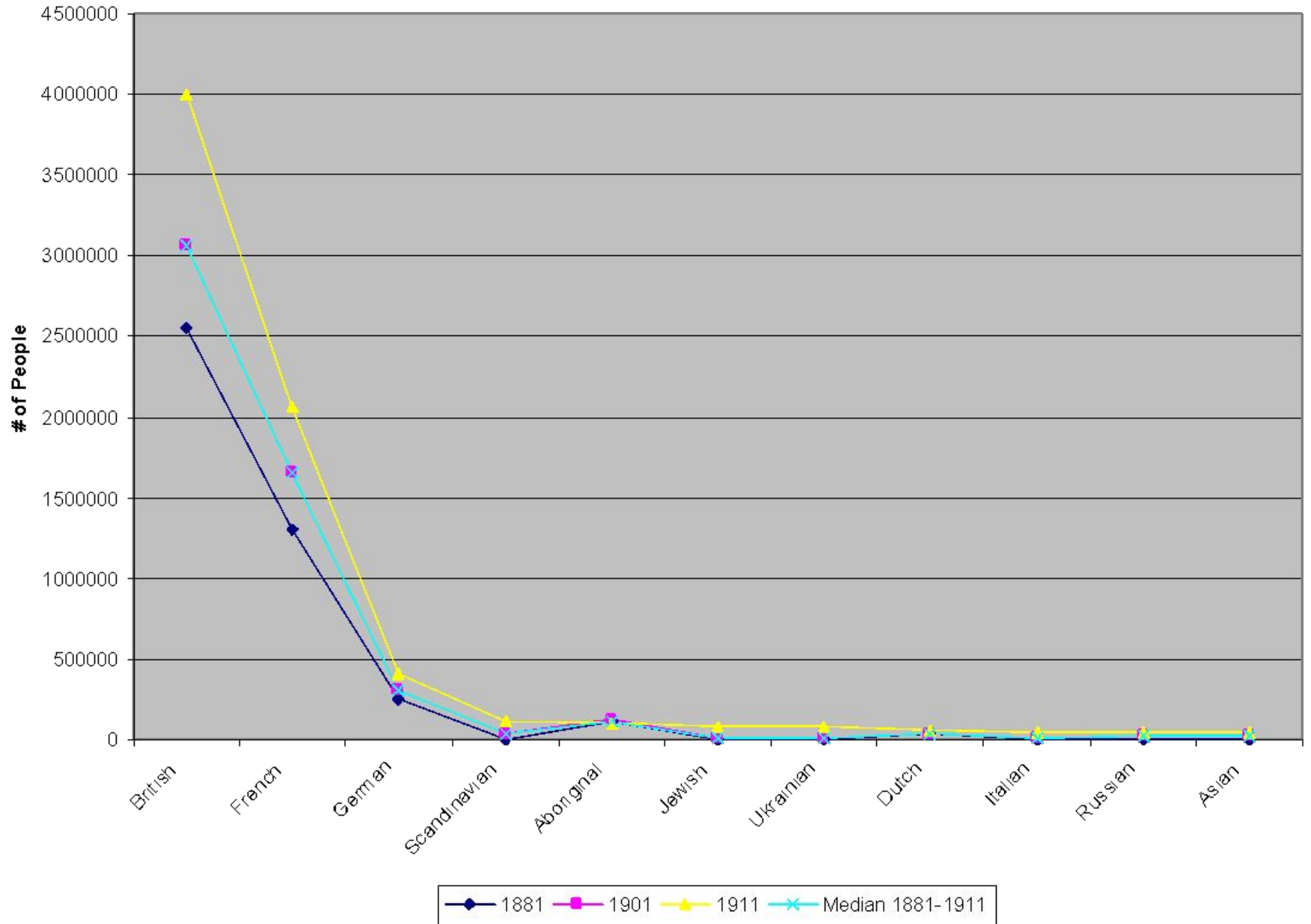

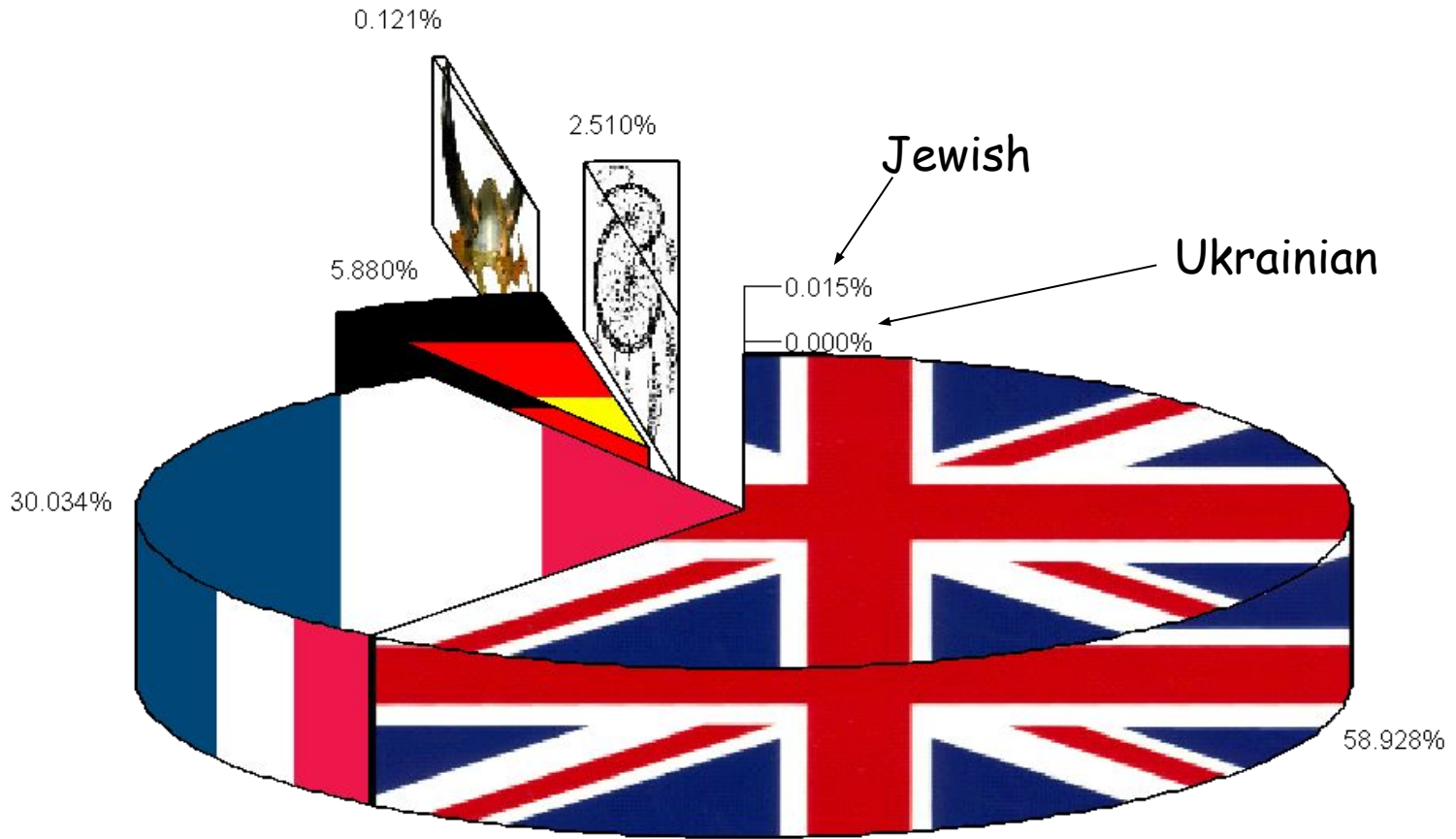
# Increase in Immigration



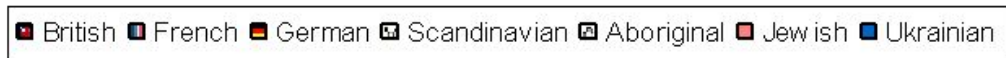
### Ethnic Origin Median



### % of Ethnic Origin 1881

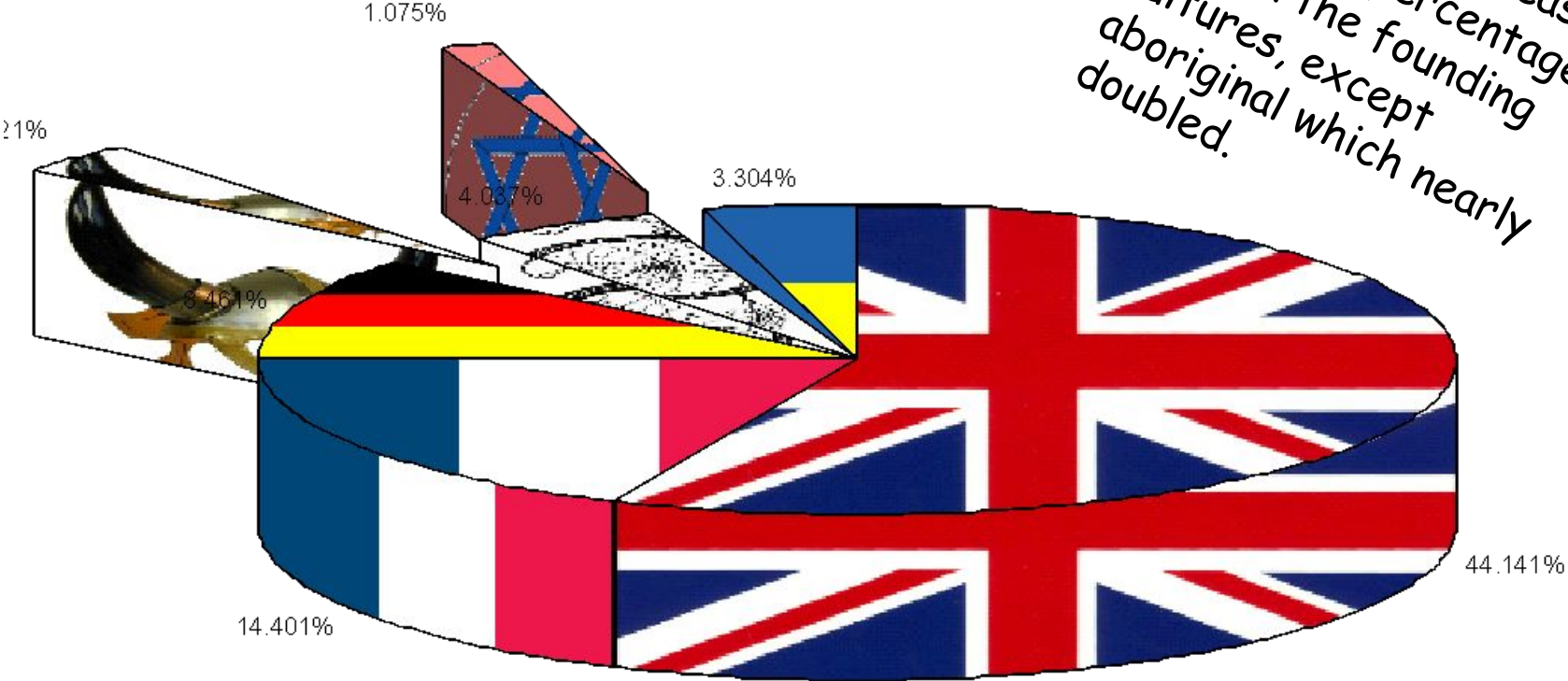


Top 7 Ethnic Groups in 1881.
