TASK TWO: Globalization in Your Home

How much of the world can be found in the place you call home?

Task:

- 1) Find **at least 10** ordinary objects in your home
- 2) Find out where that object came from in the world (they do not have to be from the countries listed above)
- 3) Turn to the world map (on the back of this sheet)
- 4) Clearly label and colour the country on the map the object originated from or was manufactured in
- 5) Label in straight, neat lines the name of the country and the name of the object manufactured in that country that you found in your home (if there is not enough room in the country for the names, make a straight line pointing to the country and label from the line)

Goal: See how much of the world you can find contained in your house or property.

Hints: Check the labels and stickers on objects. Use an atlas if you do not yet know where the country is located. The internet (if you have access) can be an excellent source to find out the origins of an object- careful, not all information on the internet is accurate, use your judgement.

Examples:

Coffee- from Ethiopia (in Africa), Columbia or Brazil.

Sharpie marker- made in USA

Remember to both colour and clearly label the countries on the map!!!
