
The following **SSTIC** acronym may help you better understand how political cartoons are made. Try to use these terms in the analysis of the cartoons you encounter.

- **S Symbolism** many cartoonists use symbolism in their cartoons
- S Size the size of items in the cartoon can sometimes imply a certain meaning
- T Text even though cartoons are visual, reading the text is crucial to understanding
- I Imagery using a well-known image to evoke a certain understanding
- C Color sometimes certain color can create a tone or mood to the cartoon
