
Where in Google Earth is That?

The game is designed to challenge your understanding of the basic political geography of the world. The game goes like this:

Teacher divides the class into two teams

A player from each team is given a laser pointer.

A round consists of one player from a team designated to play.

The first designated player will be challenged with a place to locate on the screen. The teacher spins the virtual globe in Google Earth and the player is afforded one opportunity to STOP the globe. The player can then ZOOM in until they say stop once. The player then has 5 seconds to identify the country with their laser pointer.

If the player correctly identifies the country they are awarded 2 points. If the player fails to identify the country correctly, their opponent has five seconds to identify the country. If the opponent is able to correctly identify the country they are awarded 1 point with the steal.

Players without the pointer are asked to remain silent during the round.
