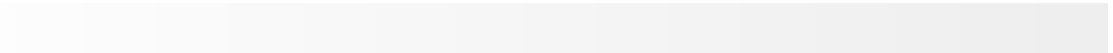

Where in Google Earth is That?

- Location 1 Hints: The country is an important trading partner of Canada.
The city is a national capital.
There is a 555 ft monument in this picture.
- Location 2 Hints: The vast majority of this picture is a barren desert..
An important international waterway is in the picture.
You might find a Pyramid nearby.
- Location 3 Hints: A large theme park in North America.
It is not a Disneyland or Six Flags park.
The theme park is owned by Paramount.
- Location 4 Hints: Located in the state with the host city of the 1996 Summer Olympics
Tiger Woods won his first major championship on this golf course.
You win a 'Green Jacket' if you win a tournament at this course.
- Location 5 Hints: Located in a country with the second biggest population in the world.
Complex in the picture is a Man-made Travel Wonders of the World list.
Complex is sometimes called "the Taj".
- Location 6 Hints: The bear is a symbol of this country.
St. Basil's Cathedral is in the middle-right of the screen.
The tomb of Vladimir Ilyich Ulyanov is in the picture.
- Location 7 Hints: Look carefully at the compass for direction.
Most people in class have been to this location.
A portion of a famous National Park.
- Location 8 Hints: Many products we buy come through here as a hub of global trade.
Area used to be a colonial possession of Great Britain.
Area was originally given to Britain as a result of the Opium Wars.

Location 9 Hints: On 20 December 1989, 27 000 US personnel invaded this country.
Important waterway in the picture opened in 1914.
The canal connects the Atlantic and Pacific oceans.
