Bears Doubles Game Instructions

Materials:

- 6 sided dice
- Game board
 - o Place game board in page protector to make it last longer
- Integer/bingo chips or other manipulatives to use as bees


Instructions:

- Player 1 rolls the dice. This tells you how many bees per bear. Player 1 can choose to build it or say the answer. He/she covers that value on his/her side of the board. For example, Pat rolls a 3. Each bear gets 3 bees. Altogether that's 6 bees so Pat covers 6.
- Player 2 rolls the dice, finds the double and covers a number on his/her side of the board.
- If your number is already covered, you lose your turn.
- The first player to cover their side of the board wins.





6 sided die 6 counters each








10 sided die 10 counters each




